It's my pleasure to write this letter of recommendation for Captain Fred Kirijan. Fred and I first met at Delta Air Lines in 1991. Fred was a senior instructor and FAA designated examiner on the B-767 fleet, and I had taken a position as the AQP (Advanced Qualification Program) Coordinator for Delta. At that time no airline had yet developed an AQP, and Fred and I worked together with the FAA on that program for about three years. When we finally tested our first AQP curricula, I volunteered to be one of the test students and Fred took over as manager of the AQP programs. Over the next few years, Fred led the team in developing AQP programs for the B-737, MD-88, and 777 fleets.

These programs also included the development of Instructor and Evaluator curricula. Additionally, AQP requires a rigorous data collection and analysis that would be collected by the instructors and evaluators, and used by the airline and the FAA to continually monitor the effectiveness of the curricula. We're still operating the AQP programs that Fred developed over 10 years ago at Delta.

As I worked closely with Fred over the years, I've seen Fred's passion for doing a job the right way. Fred is very bright, and can zero in on the keys to unlocking complex tasks like pilot performance data collection and analysis, curriculum design, development of qualification standards, teaching and evaluating crew resource management issues.
